hazards. It uses [pictograms](#),
[hazard statements](#), and the
[signal words](#) “Danger” and
“Warning” to communicate
hazard information on

product labels and safety data
sheets in a logical and
comprehensive way. The
primary goal of GHS is better
protection of human health
and the environment by
providing chemical users and
handlers with enhanced and
consistent information on
chemical hazards.”
